



## 2024 Spring Scholarship Program

### Three Scholarship Categories:

- \$750 scholarship to an active duty military member
- \$750 scholarship to a veteran
- \$750 Scholarship to a military spouse or dependent

### Eligibility:

Students currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program at an ACME sponsored college with a minimum GPA of 2.75 for an undergraduate student, or minimum GPA of 3.0 for a graduate student.

### Requirements (**Failure to provide required documents will void eligibility and essay will not be reviewed**):

- **Essay Topic:**  
*How will this scholarship benefit you and how will you intend to use the scholarship?*  
**(2 paragraphs minimum and 5 paragraph maximum).**
- Essays are due by May 15, 2024 11:59 CST. Recipients will be announced May 27, 2024 on our website and social media.
- Scholarship winners will be determined by quality of essay submitted
- Scholarship must be redeemed by August 15, 2024
- Scholarship will be made payable directly to the student and can be used for tuition, books, or fees; once criteria is verified
- Include the following with your submission:
  - All categories: **Unofficial transcripts**
  - Current military members: **JST/CCAF**
  - Veterans: **DD214**
  - Spouse or Dependent: **Marriage/Birth Certificate along with the military members LES or DD214.**
